

InclusiGardens: Digital and Sustainable Pathways to Social Inclusion through Urban Gardening is an Erasmus+ Small-Scale Partnership project in the field of adult education, bringing together three organisations: Društvo za permakulturo Slovenije (Slovenia), Pučko otvoreno učilište Čakovec (Croatia), and eVRgreen Studio (the Netherlands).

Project's main goal is to empower urban dwellers, particularly those who are marginalised or vulnerable, by offering accessible, hands-on resources for sustainable urban micro-gardening. InclusiGardens focuses on fostering social inclusion, promoting zero-waste principles, and supporting community engagement through open educational materials and collaborative learning.
